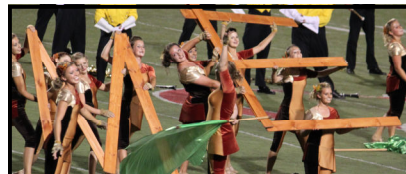

The Marching Woodmen earned a Gold at the ISSMA District Contest.

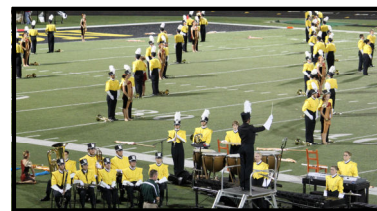
They were also awarded Best General Effect and Best Visual.
